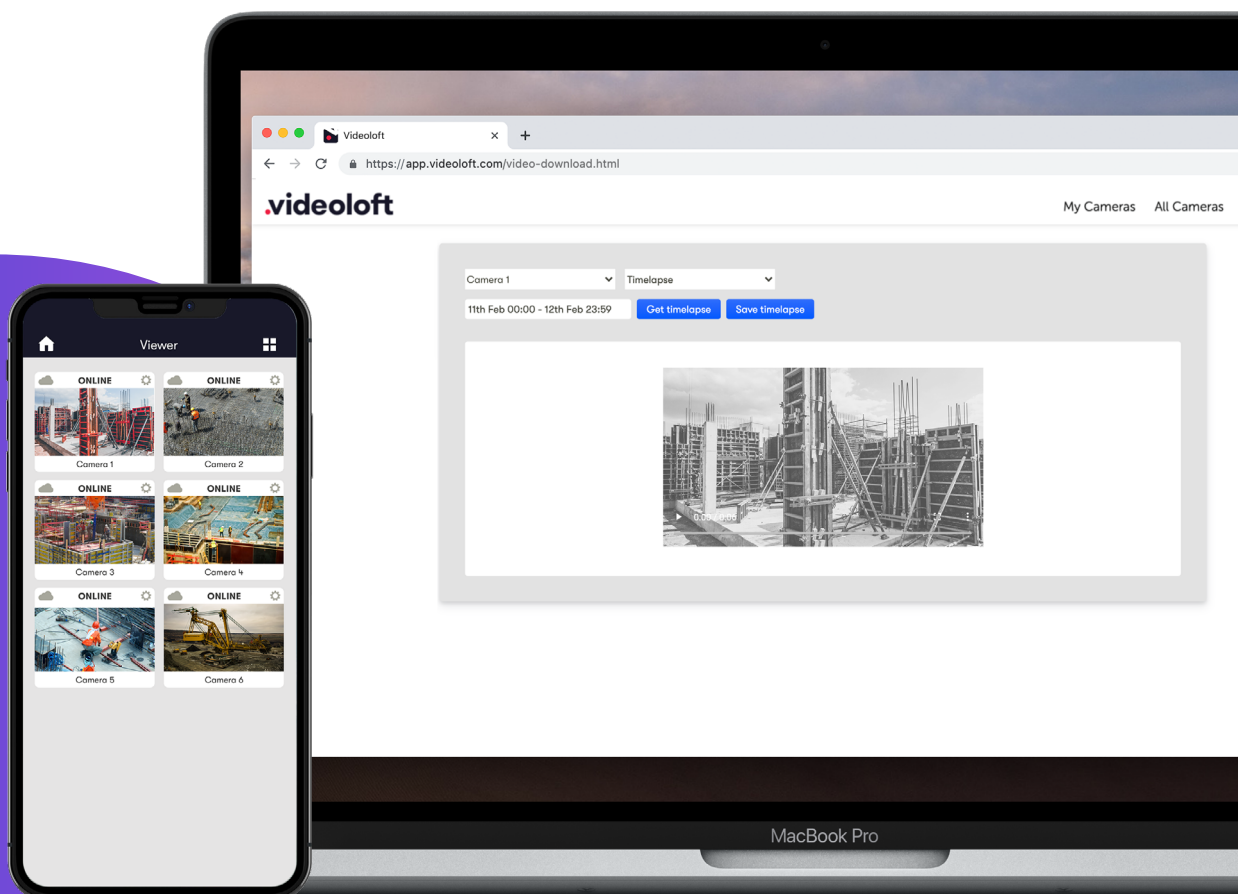

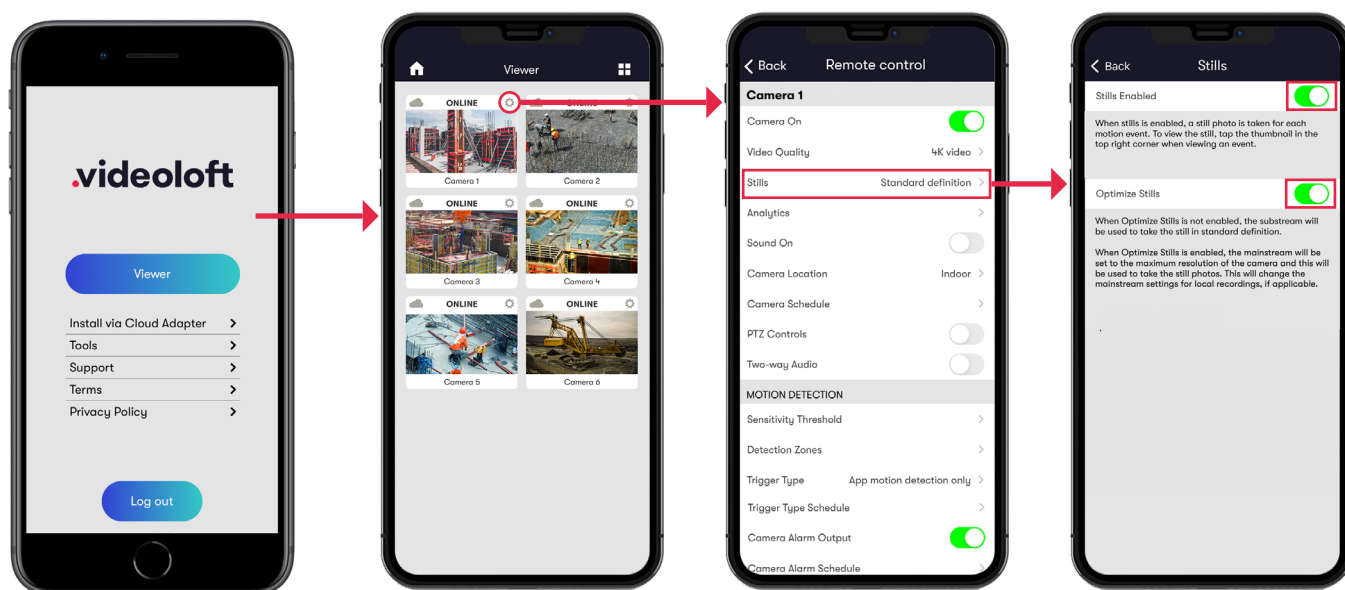
- Track your project progress with day-to-day timelapse video.
- Easily share the timelapse video with your customers.
- The timelapse will be created using every still image taken by the camera during the time period specified (a still image is taken every time the camera detects motion).



Enabling stills to allow timelapse creation

To make a timelapse using Videoloft you'll first need to enable stills through the Videoloft app:

- From the app main menu tap on 'Viewer'.
- Tap on the settings icon of the camera you wish to enable stills for.
- Tap on 'Stills', then use the 1st toggle button to enable the stills. The substream will be used to take the still in standard definition.
- To optimize the stills, use the 2nd toggle button. This will set the mainstream to the maximum resolution of the camera and this will be used to take the still photos. Please note: you can only optimize the stills when your 'Video Quality' is set to SD, so the video will be recorded at standard definition.



Creating timelapse

- Visit app.videoloft.com/video-download.html and log in to your account.
- From the 1st dropdown menu choose the camera, then from the 2nd dropdown menu choose 'Timelapse'.
- Choose the time period you want the timelapse video to cover, then click on 'Get timelapse'.
- This will generate the timelapse video from all the motion stills taken from that camera in the chosen time period. Click on 'Save timelapse' to download the video.
